

## Frequently Asked Questions

1. When is the admission notification issued?  
Ans. The notification for all courses offered by the University are published in the month of June/July every year.
2. What courses are offered in your esteemed university?  
Ans. PG Diplomas and Certificate courses, UG, PG, MBA, MBA (Hospitality and Health Care Management), B.Ed., Spl.B.Ed. and PhD courses are offered in our University. For further details kindly visit the University website, [www.braou.ac.in](http://www.braou.ac.in)
3. How to Register for Admission?  
Ans. One can register for admission through the online mode and download the University prospectus and fee details available in University portal [www.braouonline.in](http://www.braouonline.in) and pay online through AP/TS Online, Credit Card and Debit Card.
4. What are the qualifications to study Bachelors' Degree in your University?  
Ans. One should pass Intermediate or equivalent i.e. I.T.I. / Polytechnic for admission to Degree programme and should have completed 18 years of age.
5. Can I change my Address and study centre?  
Ans. Yes, you can change your address and study centre.
6. What is the procedure to take MBA Admission?  
Ans. You need to pass any Bachelors' Degree and also qualify the ICET conducted by Govt. of Telangana/Andhra Pradesh
7. What is the eligibility criteria for admission into MBA Hospital and Health Care Management (HHCM)?  
Ans. One should qualify Bachelors' degree and should pass the Entrance Exam.
8. Can I study PG in your university?  
Ans. Yes, you need to pass Bachelors' degree in the relevant subject.
9. What are the eligible criteria for admission to B.Ed./B.Ed.( Spl. Edn.) ?  
Ans. One should pass Bachelors' degree (50% marks and 40% for SC/ ST/BC/ P.W.D. ) D.Ed., or 2 year Teacher Training Course and a pass in the Entrance Exam for admission to B.Ed. Programme.  
One should pass Bachelor degree degree (50% marks and 40% for SC/ ST/BC/ P.W.D. ) and qualify in the Entrance Exams for admission to B.Ed.(Spl. Edn.)
10. Are U.G. Programmes semesterised ?  
Ans : Yes, under the newly adopted CBCS pattern, UG programmes are semesterized.
11. How many hours of face-to-face Contact-cum-Counseling sessions are provided?  
Ans. For UG: Optional 12 hrs, each class 2 hrs  
PG: 16 classes' 1 and half hr each  
Languages: 4 classes, semester 8, 2 hours each class  
Gender Sensitisation: 2 hrs (course type AECC)  
Science and technology (GE): 2 classes, 4 hrs

B.Sc. Practicals: 24 hours in each subject/ each semester  
; 6 hrs – home experiments.

12. What is the medium of instruction for UG?

Ans : The medium of instruction available with University are (1) Telugu, (2) English (3) Urdu

13. Whether attending the Counseling sessions is mandatory?

Ans. No, but for practical courses 75% attendance is compulsory.

14. What is the role of Multimedia teaching learning in distance education?

Ans. Apart from the course material, multimedia teaching learning in distance education provides an interactive way for learners to gain knowledge about their subjects.

15. Does the university provide Multimedia teaching learning facilities?

Ans. Dr.BRAOU offers multimedia teaching learning through the medium of video lessons, T-SAT, Video Lessons, Radio lessons and Live Teleconferencing.

16. Does the university have Library facilities/ Book Learning Facilities?

Ans. Yes, the University offers library facilities to its learners.

17. Is there any student assessment system?

Ans. Yes, through assignments and examinations

18. Can I have the option to choose a Study Centre, an Examination Centre?

Ans. You can choose Study Centre to attend classes related to your specific subject. But, for appearing in your examinations, you will be assigned same Study Centre that you have previously enrolled in.

19. Is there option for an online examination?

Ans. Presently, the University does not provide the facilities for online examinations.

20. Are the courses offered by the Dr.BRAOU recognised by the UGC and other national and International bodies?
